### [InterLibrary Loan](#)

Libraries worldwide will scan chapters and articles into PDF's straight into your email via InterLibrary Loan requests. As circumstances are changing frequently, please consult this page for up-to-date information on library services.

### [Software](#) - UCI Office of Information Technology

Download software\* for free on your personal devices, including: Microsoft Office 365, Matlab, ArcGIS, Mathematica; JMP, Stata, and other research software is available at a reduced price through OIT.

\*Note that software typically must be renewed annually at the end of June. [Virtual Labs](#) are available for additional software.

### [LastPass Password Manager](#)

Anyone can create a free, basic LastPass account to securely store passwords across your devices. UCI also has an Enterprise\* account, which includes 1GB of encrypted file storage at no cost.

\*Note that access ends one year after graduation, so back up your data if you decide to utilize the LastPass Enterprise account!

## [ORCID ID](#)

A unique, persistent, digital identifier for authors. Use this ID every time you publish to track your publications automatically.

## [Citation / Bibliographic Management Software](#)

If you aren't yet using a citation manager, now is the time! Popular choices include Zotero (open-source), EndNote, and Mendeley. Talk to faculty advisors and peers to find out if there is a preferred option.

## [Dryad](#)

An open-access data repository where you can upload your research data to make it both discoverable and easily citable. Contact [Digital Scholarship Services](#) for more information, including GIS and Data Carpentries and more.

## [Overleaf](#)

A collaborative, cloud-based, LaTeX editor for the writing, editing, and publishing of scientific documents. Integrates directly with Zotero, Mendeley, and CiteULike, and can also be used with RefWorks, EndNote, and Paperpile citation management programs. Choose *Sign Up* and register by entering your UCI email and a new password for Overleaf (not the password you use for UCInetID).
